21-22 School Year Data Warehouse Reporting Templates

Student Lite Template

- New Gender: Non-binary: X (also on Staff Snapshot)
- Address Fields
 - No PO Box in the address field
 - Cannot have a blank phone number
 - If no phone use the number most frequently used to contact the student's primary guardian
- Guardian
 - Only one guardian in the name field

Student Lite Template

- > Career Pathway: CIVIC
 - Earned Seal of Civic Readiness
 - Scored passing on at least one of each ELA, Math, Science and only 1 Social Studies Regents AND earned Seal of Civic Readiness

School Entry Exit

- ➤ New Enrollment in Reason Code
 - 8250-HSE Outcome Reporting: used for recording students who exited school within prior 24 months and subsequently earned HSE (high school equivalency diploma)
 - End with an 816-Earned a High School Equivalency Diploma
 - Enroll for a full day i.e. enter 12/15 and exit 12/16
 - Student must not have a 0011 or 5654 enrollment in during the same school year when using 8250
 - Student must be in a cohort that is active during the reporting school year
 - Only applies to College, Career and Civic Readiness Reporting



Program Fact

➤ Program Fact

- New 3050- ELL Eligibility Exit Using August/September 20-21 NYSITELL Score only
 - Used for students who were provisionally identified in 19-20 or 20-21 and took the Special NYSITELL Administration and were determined not eligible
- New 8313-Received Seal of Civic Readiness
 - Pilot program in 21-22 School Year
 - Only two districts in our area are in the Pilot Group
 - Student must meet the criteria to earn the Seal of Civic Readiness

Student Daily Attendance

- Delete Present and Tardy
- New Attendance Codes
 - Present-In and Tardy-In: student is physically in the building
 - Present-Out and Tardy-Out: student is not physically in the building
- Instructional Modality
 - **Remote** The student received instruction remotely for the day. The student and teacher(s) are not in the same physical location for in-person instruction for the day.
 - **In-Person** The student and teacher(s) are in the same physical location for the day for where a teacher is delivering in-person instruction.
 - **Both** The student's instruction was both remote and in-person for instruction on the same day.
- District Policy
 - Districts should continue to use local policy to determine a student's attendance

 - Enrolled in a course of study and earn credit that would ordinarily culminate in the January 2022 Regents Examination in United States History and Government (Framework) and earn credit for such course of study by the end of the first semester of the 2021-22 school year; or
 - Successfully complete a make-up program for the purpose of earning course credit in a course that would ordinarily culminate in the taking of the Regents Examination in United States History and Government (Framework) between September 1, 2021, and the end of the first semester of the 2021-22 school year: or
 - Are preparing to take the Regents Examination in United States History and Government (Framework) to graduate at the end of the first semester of the 2021-22 school year



Student Digital Access

- > Student Digital Access Templates
 - Used to identify specific needs and target resources and funding opportunities when they become available
 - NYS has just completed development of the questions and answers that districts should use
 - Will be extracted from the Student Management Systems
 - Student Management Systems (SMS) are working on solutions within their packages to collect and extract this data

Student Digital Access

- > Student Digital Access Templates
 - Student Digital Access is reported by the entity where the student is for their full day of instruction
 - Minimum one record per student grades K-12 including ungraded
 - A new record should be reported if student moves to a new building
 - Data should be updated throughout the year if answers change as is feasible

- ➤ Do not report two sections of the same course with the same students particularly in 3-8
- ➤ PK-2 grades need to have a course mapped to one of the NYS course codes listed below for the calculation of student average class sizes
 - Grade PK-73029
 - Grade K-73030
 - Grade 1-73031
 - Grade 2-73032
- ➤ Student average class sizes are calculated K-2, 3-8 ELA and Math, 4 & 8 Science and high school classes ending in a Regents
- Share Course Catalog link with school counselors
- Share SCED Crosswalk with HR staff and principals

Staff Reporting

- > Teachers are required to have their certifications in place at the start of the school year.
- ➤ Due to a significant increase in certificate applications, including review of emergency certificates related to COVID-19, the department is not identifying teachers as out of certification for their courses if they have the appropriate certificate in place prior to the final certification match during the school year.
- ➤ Teachers with expiring certifications during the school year, should ensure they make provisions several months in advance to provide the Office of Teaching Initiatives (OTI) with the necessary documentation needed to issue certifications
- Mark Special Education teachers and ENL teachers with the appropriate indicators

AIS Determinations

AIS Determinations

- > Due to the late release of 3-8 Assessment Scores:
 - Two Step Process:
 - Review students performing below median scale score between Level 2 Partially proficient and Level 3 proficient on 3-8 ELA or Math shall be considered for AIS

And a student's performance on multiple measures such as:

- Developmental reading assessments for grades K-6;
- New York State English as a Second Language Achievement Test (NYSESLAT);
- Benchmark and lesson-embedded assessments for reading and math in grades K-6 based on teacher designed and selected assessments;
- Common formative assessments that provide information about students' skills;
- Unit and lesson assessments for ELA, mathematics, science, social studies and Languages Other than English (LOTE) for grades 7-8; and/or
- Results of psychoeducational evaluations based on a variety of assessments and inventories.
- OR: make an identification based solely on district-developed procedures applicable to all grade 3-8 students during the 2021-2022 school year.



Level 0 Updates



Level 0

- Multi-factor Authentication (MFA)
 - Authorizes each user by trusted device
 - Will be set for a range by the hosting site
 - User will be prompted for a 6-digit PIN which used will receive via email
 - PIN is active for 15 minutes
 - After 3 unsuccessful PIN entries, user will be locked out for 15 minutes

Level 0

- ➤ L1 Data Prep
 - Combine the "Lock" and "Create File for Level 1 Data Submission" into one button
 - When you lock your data, it will also send up to L1Center
 - Make sure templates are sent in "dependency order"
 - Save copy of the files that you send
